

## Can you provide additional funding to Kingshill?



### Your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium!

You can check by emailing Mr Plumb at [head@kingshill.herts.sch.uk](mailto:head@kingshill.herts.sch.uk) and simply giving your National Insurance Number and Full Name! It's as easy as that!

### What do you receive if you are eligible for Pupil Premium?

**Free Meals:** Currently, pupils in Years 1 and 2 as well as Reception children all receive free school meals, these are paid by government funding. This provision is called Universal Free School Meals or UFSM. Signing up for Pupil Premium funding early ensures your child/children can receive free school meals in subsequent school years (Year 3 and onwards) so it's well-worth signing up early.

At Kingshill, if you are eligible for Pupil Premium Funding, we offer:

- Discounted educational trips:** We will discount all trips for your child throughout your time at Kingshill.
- Half-price after school club throughout the week:** Our brilliant after school club, Treetops, will be half-price for you every day of the week.
- One free extra-curricular club per week:** We offer one free extra-curricular club for Pupil Premium Children per week. This could be basketball, multi-sports, singing, LEGO or cooking club! Take your pick.
- Free access to PTA events throughout the year:** Events such as the Summer Fair, Christmas events such as Santa's Grotto and other exciting events will all be offered free.
- 1:1 Reading Tutoring:** All Pupil Premium Children can access 1:1 Reading Tutoring if required during their time at Kingshill.
- Half-term and holiday supermarket vouchers:** From time-to-time, depending on council funding, Hertfordshire County Council offers vouchers for children to buy lunches during the holiday. These range between £15 and £90.

### Are you eligible?

You can register your child for Free School Meals if you receive any of these benefits:

- A sudden change in circumstance or if you've lost your job.
- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) that does not exceed £16,190
- Working Tax Credit 'run-on' - the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Please note you are not eligible if you are in receipt of Working Tax Credit.

How to apply:

1. Registering is really quick and easy – you can apply online at [https://www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/ufs/CHSERV\\_FSMREG.eb?ebd=0&ebz=1\\_1699304000493](https://www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/ufs/CHSERV_FSMREG.eb?ebd=0&ebz=1_1699304000493) and get an immediate answer. If you are eligible, your child's school will be notified within 5 working days.

***The information that you supply to register for Pupil Premium will be held securely and will only be used for the purpose of establishing entitlement to Pupil Premium and to contact other sources, as allowed by law, to verify your initial and continuing entitlement. If in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, you must notify Kingshill Infant School in writing of any changes to your financial circumstances.***
