	<p>Art in EYFS is covered through Expressive Arts and Design.</p> <p>Children in EYFS have access to continuous provision, which has high quality open-end resources. They manipulate playdough, and other fine motor activities to support finger strength in preparation for the fine art being taught in KS1. They are encouraged to select the tools and resources they will need to create their artwork, independently. They develop skills such as drawing, painting, sculpting, cutting and observational art. The children are inspired by nature and a range of artists to create their art through our topics.</p>

	<p>In Key Stage One, we follow the requirements of the National Curriculum for Art.</p> <p>In Key Stage 1 Art and Design, children explore and develop their creativity and imagination. They learn to use a variety of materials, tools, and techniques to express ideas, experiences, and observations. Pupils are introduced to basic elements of art such as color, line, shape, texture, and pattern, and begin to evaluate their own work and that of others.</p> <p>They also learn about the work of famous artists, craft makers, and designers, using them as inspiration for their own creations. The focus is on experimenting, exploring, and enjoying art-making.</p>
