**TOP TEN RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES PRIMARY SCHOOL CHARTER**

- 1 I SHOULD FEEL SAFE AND ENJOY MYSELF ONLINE
- 2 I SHOULD BE ABLE TO TELL SOMEONE IF SOMEBODY HAS WORRIED ME ON THE INTERNET
- 3 I SHOULD NOT BE BULLIED ON THE INTERNET, AND SHOULD NOT BULLY OTHERS
- 4 I SHOULD HELP MY FRIENDS STAY SAFE ON THE INTERNET
- 5 I SHOULD BE ABLE TO REPORT ANYTHING THAT WORRIES ME OR THE INTERNET
- 6 I SHOULD BE ABLE TO TALK AND PLAY ON THE INTERNET WITH MY FRIENDS
- 7 I SHOULD NOT HAVE TO GET UNPLEASANT OR BURTLED THINGS ON THE INTERNET
- 8 I SHOULD KNOW HOW TO KEEP MY PERSONAL INFORMATION SAFE
- 9 I SHOULD BE ABLE TO SEARCH EASILY FOR INFORMATION ON THE INTERNET
- 10 I SHOULD LEARN HOW TO STAY SAFE ON THE INTERNET
